


Owls class (y2)

English	<p>We have done a few more guided reading sessions really focusing our comprehension, recall and inference skills. Maths	<p>Revision:</p> <p>We have used the lessons this week to revise our knowledge of place value and addition and subtraction. We have practiced many types with the trickiest being those that require exchanging eg:</p> 
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Topic - We took part in a Now Press Play experience learning all about the 4 countries of the UK • Science - we observed our seeds and bulbs. • RE - We talked about respect for special books as we looked at some of the features and rules within the Qur'an. We also had a go at writing (tracing) some Arabic script. • PE - In tennis we introduced the volley skill. This was trickier than forehand because the challenge is to hit the ball before it bounces on the floor. We learnt that it is a very similar skill to throwing and catching underarm. • Computing - Using our knowledge of framing our subjects and choosing either portrait or landscape we took a range of photos that we can edit in next week's lesson. • Music - working in groups we composed and wrote our own scores for a call and response composition based on the structure of a phone call.
