


Owls class (y2)

Maths	<p>Measurement:</p> <p>We moved onto a new topic of volume and capacity. We continued our bean seed observations and updated our diaries of their changes and growth so far. • RE - We discussed at the five pillars of Islam and then looked in detail at Salah - the 2nd pillar - and the importance of prayer. • Computing - We looked at how we can edit photos to either improve them or change them considerably. We then discussed how not all photos seen in the media or on the internet are real. • Music - We started to learn the Polish folk song 'Tanczymy labada' which is also sung at football matches. • PE - Tennis - we used the skills we had practised 2 weeks ago of throwing a volley and developed these into using racquets to volley the balls between our partners.
